

Truth and Reconciliation Week September 27 - October 1, 2021

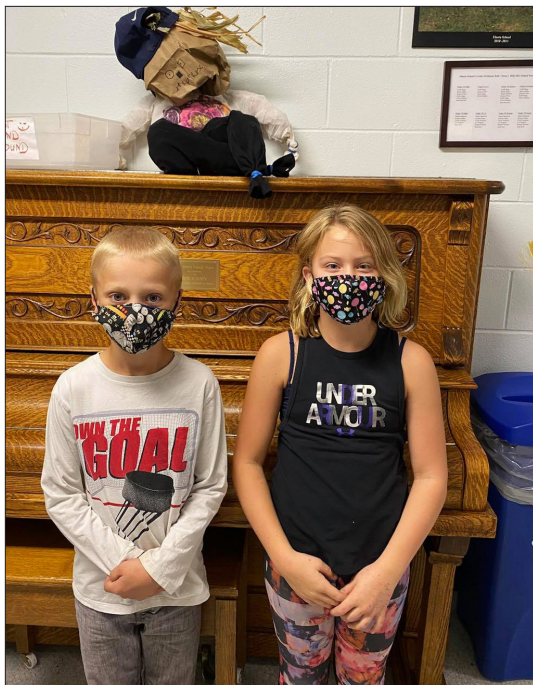
