Starting in September 2024, a Student Services Lead Teacher is in every school, working hard with staff members to support inclusive needs for all students as well as access to external resources and supports.

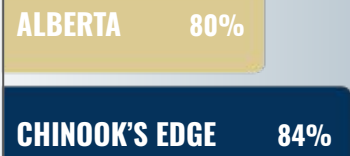


We are excited to see our attendance rates trending upwards as students, parents, and teachers work together to support student success at school!

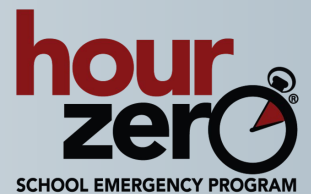
3 Year High School Completion Rate
